## To Book a Program

- **Step 1:** Pick an upcoming workshop to attend or decide whether you want to book a private workshop. Download and submit a completed **Program Registration Form** from our website. Telephone registrations are not accepted.

- **Step 2:** Someone from the Education Department will check program date availability and get back to you within **one week** of your registration. If you do not hear back after this time, please **email us**.

- **Step 3:** You will receive a contract with payment information and your program date (based on availability or workshop registered for) within **one week** of your program registration submission. Please **email** the Education Department if you have not received a confirmation.

- **Step 4:** Submit your payment, via the link on your contract or by check at the above address with a copy of your contract, to secure your selected date and time. *Note that a 10 person or \$120 minimum is required for all individually booked workshops.*





#### 3 CHEERS FOR ANIMALS

Program Length: 2.5 hours

**Journey:** *3 Cheers for Animals, Birdbath Award*

#### TIGERS IN THE WILD

Program Length: 2.5 hours

Scouts will learn the difference between what animals eat, and whether that makes them an herbivore, carnivore, omnivore, or detrivore. Discover how to identify animals and plants, and practice together.

### BEAR CUBS

#### FUR, FEATHERS, & FERNS

Program Length: 2.5 hours

**Adventure:** *Fur, Feathers, & Ferns*

Take a hike to explore native wildlife and plants. We'll look for signs of animals, tour the zoo, and discuss why some animals are disappearing from their habitat in addition to ways to help them.
