1. This mammal can keep predators away by showing off its black and white coloration.

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2. This bird uses elaborate dance moves and a unique song to attract a mate.

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3. This animal smells like popcorn! Their urine contains the same chemical compound that gives popcorn its buttery scent.

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4. This reptile lives in family groups and are arboreal (live in trees).

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5. This mammal has large ears that can rotate like satellite dishes to better detect sounds.

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6. This animal has at least 17 distinct vocalizations to communicate in dense forests.

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7. This mammal is the world's largest pollinator!

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
