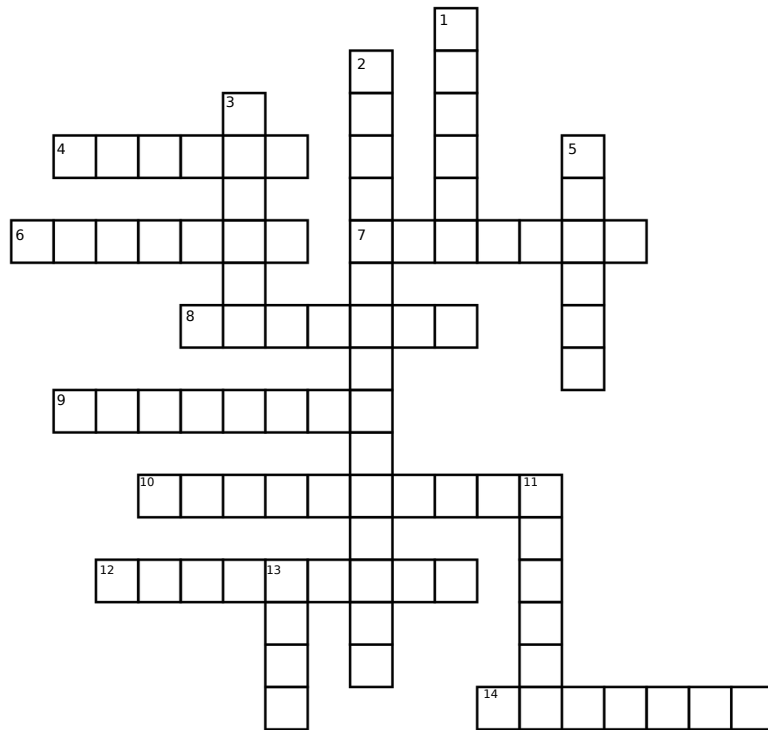


Animal Habitats



Down:

1. Sandy habitat characterized by extreme temperatures and sparse vegetation.
2. Ecosystem with deciduous trees and four distinct seasons.
3. Habitat found in high altitudes with cold temperatures and little vegetation.
5. Habitat in which animals live in underground dens, often in temperate zones.
11. Arctic habitat known for polar bears and seals.
13. Aquatic habitat with slow-moving waters, often home to fish and amphibians.

Across:

4. A type of habitat with tropical warmth and high humidity, home to diverse plant and animal life.
6. Grassland with rich soil, home to many herbivores and occasional fires!
7. Ecosystem with a mix of saltwater and freshwater, often marshy.
8. Water-rich habitat often home to amphibians and aquatic plants.
9. Coastal ecosystem with salt-tolerant plants and rich marine life.
10. Dense forest with high rainfall and rich biodiversity.
12. Marine ecosystem characterized by colorful fish and warm, shallow waters.
14. Large treeless plain where you might find bison.
