

Life Cycles

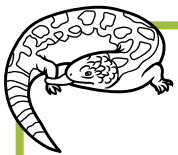
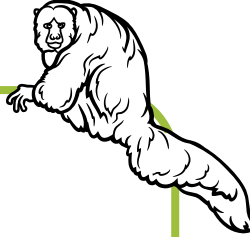
