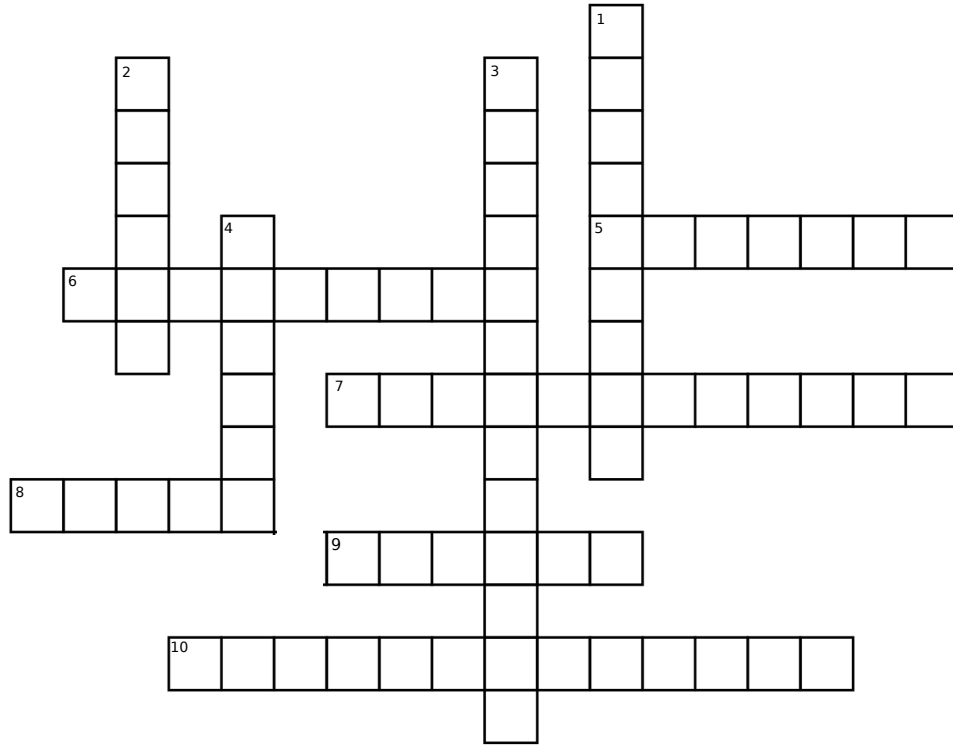


Managing Our Trash
